2011 will mark the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the last book, History of the Department of Police, Trenton, New Jersey – 1911. In the 1911 book (and the 1899 book before it) were photos of every cop on the force at the time, along with photographs of the equipment in use at the time.
